James Stewart Dunlop Sr., 68, Springfield, Mo., passed away at 2:20 p.m. Monday, Oct. 13, 1997, in St. John's Regional Health Center.

He was born Aug. 15, 1929, in Kansas City, Mo., to John E. and Marie Stewart Dunlop. He attended high school in Joplin, Mo., and was a graduate of Southwest Missouri State University. He went on to earn his Master's degree from Drury College. He formerly taught and coached at Mount Vernon and West Plains high schools. He was a teacher and coach for 31 years at Parkview High School until retiring in 1995. He also coached at Glendale High School for several years during the 1980s.
